ATTENTION: All Government Cheque Recipients

The government of Canada is phasing out cheques in favor of direct deposit by April 1, 2016. All Canadians and Canadian businesses must therefore register for direct deposit as soon as possible so as not to miss the deadline. You can visit www.directdeposit.gc.ca for more information.



Want to avoid extra ATM with-drawl fees? Look for the "Ding Free" label on Credit Union ATM machines. There will be no charge to you if you use a participating "Ding Free" machine.

Direct deposit is convenient. You have faster access to your money with virtually no risk of your payment being delayed as a result of unforeseen circumstances.

This process is reliable. Your payment will always be on time, and your money can begin to earn interest right away.

Direct Deposit is secure. Your direct deposit payment is safe and secure with virtually no risk of your payment being lost, stolen or damaged.

The enrollment forms are included in with your cheques. We also have them at the branch. Simply ask us for one and we will provide it, help you fill it in and send it for you.

Government Bill Payments

Effective immediately, Landis Credit Union will be changing the way government bill payments are processed.

Saskatchewan Payments (PST, Tobacco Tax, etc.):

- Can be mailed with payment
- Can be filed online (<http://www.finance.gov.sk.ca/taxes/efile/>) and paid using MemberDirect or in person at the credit union

Business Taxes:

- Can be paid on MemberDirect (Log in, click on payments, click on pay business tax, enter required information).
- Can be mailed with payment

Personal Tax

- Can be paid using MemberDirect (payee name: Government of Canada HRSDC account number: your sin number) or in person at the credit union
- Can be mailed with payment

Receiver General remittances will continue to be accepted as usual
