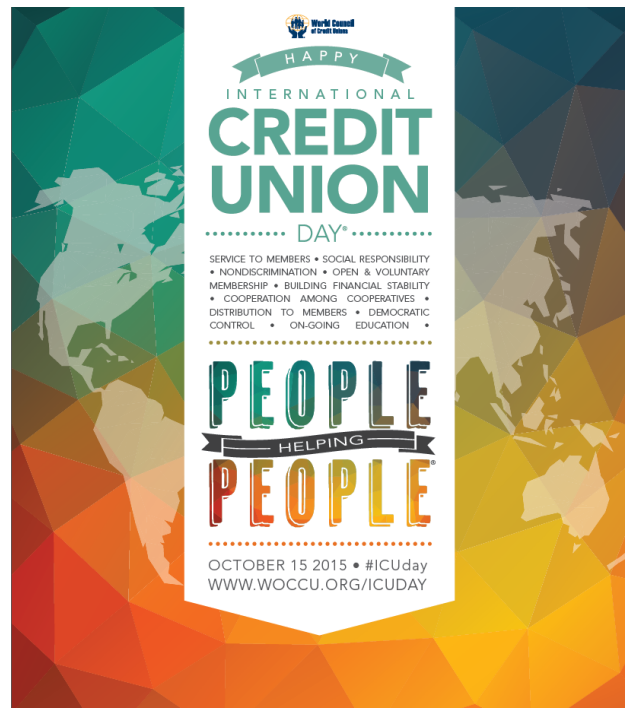

ATTENTION: All Government Cheque Recipients

The government of Canada is phasing out cheques in favor of direct deposit by April 1, 2016. All Canadians and Canadian businesses must therefore register for direct deposit as soon as possible so as not to miss the deadline. You can visit www.directdeposit.gc.ca for more information.



Want to avoid extra ATM withdrawal fees? Look for the "Ding Free" label on Credit Union ATM machines. There will be no charge to you if you use a participating "Ding Free" machine.

Direct deposit is convenient. You have faster access to your money with virtually no risk of your payment being delayed as a result of unforeseen circumstances.

This process is reliable. Your payment will always be on time, and your money can begin to earn interest right away.

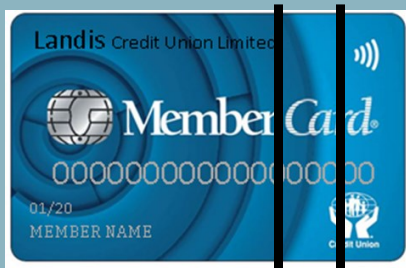
Direct Deposit is secure. Your direct deposit payment is safe and secure with virtually no risk of your payment being lost, stolen or damaged.

The enrollment forms are included in with your cheques. We also have them at the branch. Simply ask us for one and we will provide it, help you fill it in and send it for you.

Protecting your Debit Card Information

Debit card fraud is on the rise. Do you know how to protect yourself? Below are some tricks that can help keep your card information safe.

- Cover your PIN: When entering your PIN, cover the terminal to prevent cameras and those around you from viewing this information.
- Use Interac Flash on your debit card: When you use the InteracFlash feature, the card never leaves your hand, preventing the collection of information used to replicate your magnetic strip or PIN.
- Watch how far your debit card goes into a POS/ATM machine: The new debit cards have a built in security feature. When inserting your card into terminal, you should be able to see two shades of blue on you card. If you can only see the lightest blue, the card has gone in too far, enabling tampered terminals to capture the magnetic strip information. As shown below.



- Let us know if you are travelling: To ensure that your card will work when out of Canada let us know when and where you will be going ahead of time.
- Monitor your account: Be sure to check your statements within 30 days of receiving them, and let us know if anything looks unfamiliar.

Hyperwallet Service Ending

Effective February 1, 2016 Hyperwallet services will be ending. If you have a Hyperwallet account please be sure to cash out your account before this date. As of October 15, members will not be able to sign up for Hyperwallet services.

New Debit Cards

With the arrival of the new InteracFlash Debit cards, you are now able to simply tap your card to pay for small purchases at participating stores.

Make sure to switch your login ID to your new number for online banking.
