

Credit Union Day Events


Credit Union Day is October 20. Thank you to everyone who participated in Credit Union Day either at the branch or the supper and Wills and Estates Seminar.

Accessing your account is now much more convenient. With mobile web our online banking Website will be optimized to your screen size, so you can view the website from your smart phone.


Most functions that you use on the original site will be available on Mobile Web including viewing balances, and recent transactions, paying bills, and transferring funds. To preform other functions click on the Home button to be redirected to the original site.



If you are using an iPhone: Save the link to your phone's home screen by clicking on the button circled in green above and then click Add to Home Screen, If you are using an Android: Save the link to your phone's home screen by click on the button circled in green to the right and then click Add to Home Screen. Be Wary of Online Classified Scams

Everyone wants a deal—especially when you are purchasing a items from the classifieds. So when the individual who has agreed to purchase your goods or service sends a cheque for more than the amount agreed to, alarm bells should be raised!!!

Overpayment scams are quite commonly perpetrated on online classified advertising services such as Kijiji, Ebay, Craigslist. This type of scam occurs when the seller receives payment via a cheque in an amount in excess of the amount originally agreed to in the transaction. They are then asked to deposit the cheque and return the excess funds back to the originator by wire transfer.

Often the cheque sent to the seller originates from an unrelated business or corporation and/or from another province; the reasoning behind the overpayment is explained to cover courier fees or taxes.

While simple in their approach, these scams are still proving to be very successful in victimizing CU members.
