Inter-Credit Union Banking

Did you know you can make deposits or withdrawals to and from any Credit Union account at any Saskatchewan Credit Union?

All you will need is your debit card.

At most credit unions you have 2 options available to you:

-use the ATM to make your deposit or withdrawal.

-ask the staff to assist you with the CEBS machine to make a deposit or withdrawal.

Did you know that you can change your debit card, Global Payment MasterCard, and CUETs MasterCard PIN at most Saskatchewan Credit Unions?

If you know the current PIN you can use the ATM to change it.

If you do not know your PIN ask a staff member to assist you with changing the PIN.

Same Day CUETs MasterCard Payments

Processing a bill payment usually takes 2-3 business days, but we can now process CUETs MasterCard payments in 1 day if required. Bring in the CUETs MasterCard that you want paid, let us know it needs to be paid today and we can process the payment for you.
